Statement of the Syndicate of soldiers of Slovenia

The Syndicate of soldiers of Slovenia as a representative syndicate in military professions soldier, non-commissioned officer and officer and in the defence activity, which represents the employees of the Slovenian armed forces, gives its

STATEMENT OF UNCOORDINATION

with a draft law on the payment of imbalances

and with it we do not consent, because in it there are *provisions* on the execution of judgements by the suggested law. It was agreed at the meeting on the 4th November that these provisions are eliminated from the draft law. In it the 4th article of the draft law has been deleted, while the 2nd paragraph of the 1st article, which has the same meaning in substance as the deleted 4th article, remained. This sort of a draft law represents a rough interference in judicial decisions and the court branch of power. Therefore this is **unacceptable for the Syndicate of soldiers of Slovenia.**

We also express our outrage because of

**the discrimination of the profession group of the members of the Slovenian armed forces
which are represented by the Syndicate of soldiers of Slovenia,**

because while preparing the statement of coordination draft law for the repayment of imbalances at the end of yesterday's negotiations **there has been an incident.** The government negotiation side **did not want to even mention the Syndicate of soldiers of Slovenia** in the statement of coordination, which was at the end paraphrased, despite the syndicate representative's constant presence at the negotiations and despite its representativeness. Despite multiple demands from the SVS president Gvido Novak the government side did not want to state (in the statement of coordination) that the representative of the Syndicate of soldiers of Slovenia has been present at the negotiations, much less that the syndicate specifically does not concur with the draft law, upon which most of the syndicates agreed – especially those, which do not have litigation proceedings in court and find the law in their favour. The draft law is not in favour for anyone, which already has judgements or their proceedings in court are not finished yet, because with the draft law they **wish to determine the execution of the judgements of the courts**, therefore the already set **deadlines of payments in judgements in the proposed law will be illegal** and the enforcement procedures will be stopped. **Anyone who has sought their right in court and succeeded in doing so will be punished** for it with the proposed law and the ones, which did nothing to protect their rights and speak the loudest today, will be rewarded.
